Conservatory Ensembles

As the leading pre-professional musical theatre training program in Alabama, the RMTC Conservatory has dedicated educational goals for each of its ensembles to guide the members' development as young artists. Each ensemble focuses on performance skills that are tailored specifically toward developmentally appropriate goals and concepts:

Previews (Ages 9-12)

The Previews' overarching goal is to understand and demonstrate the fundamentals of musical theatre performance.

Tuition: \$800

Spotlights (Ages 11-15)

The Spotlights' overall objective is to refine their techniques of musical theatre performance. They truly build upon the fundamentals and focus further on mastering technique of performance skills.

Tuition: \$1,100

Performing Ensemble (Ages 13-18)

The Performing Ensemble's overall goal is to express the artistry of musical theatre storytelling. This type of craftsmanship requires attention to detail and cannot be achieved without mastery of musical theatre techniques.

Performing Ensemble members will also take an all-expenses paid trip to iTheatrics Junior Theatre Festival in Atlanta (includes three nights' lodging, meals, and registration fees associated with the festival).
